# Sargent County Museum Wish List for New Building


Here is your chance to purchase items that the museum will need for the new building going up in May 2024. If you would like to purchase an item please email at

We are also looking for some black metal music stands that are not being used. They will become our easels and flipbook stands. We will fix them if they do not move or if they always slide down.




