#### Sargent County Museum Wish List for New Building


Here is your chance to purchase items that the museum will need for the new building going up in May 2024. If you would like to purchase an item please email at



#### Curtis Larson

Curtis Roger Larson was born May 8, 1948 in Crookston, MN to John A. and Clarinda (Lewis) Larson and lived on the family farm in rural Fertile, MN until he graduated from Fertile High School in 1966. He attended one year at Moorhead State University in Moorhead, MN and then transferred to North Dakota State University, Fargo, ND. He met Renee Sundquist at NDSU, Fargo and they were married on May 1, 1971 at Trinity Lutheran Church, Forman, ND. They have two children: Melissa and Kristian. Curt started his career at White Drug, Fargo, ND. In 1973, Curt and Renee moved to Alexandria, MN where Curt became the Assistant Manager at White Mart. Curt and Renee moved to Evansville, MN



in 1979 where they owned a hardware store. In 1983, they moved back to Alexandria when Curt purchased RV Graphics, a small job printing company.

In 1993, Curt began his public ministry as a youth worker and assistant to the pastor at Osakis Lutheran Church. After several years of study, Curt was commissioned as an Associate in Ministry in December, 1996. Curt left Osakis in January 1997 and moved with Renee and family to Longview, WA where Curt was the Church Administrator and Adult Education Director at Emmanuel Lutheran Church. In February 2001, Curt was called to serve at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Lowry, MN. In November, 2007, Curt was called to serve Milnor Lutheran, Milnor, ND and Immanuel Lutheran, rural DeLamere, ND where he served until his retirement from full-time ministry on December 31, 2012. Curt and Renee moved to their retirement home in Forman, ND.

After retirement, Curt and Renee became members of Nordland Lutheran Church, Rutland, ND and Trinity Lutheran Church, Forman, ND. Curt was a substitute school bus driver for Sargent Central School, Forman, ND for several years. Since 2012, Curt has provided pulpit supply preaching in area churches and short-term interim positions at Nordland Lutheran, Rutland, ND, Havana Trinity, Havana, ND and at Epiphany of Christ Lutheran, Apache Junction, AZ. Since 2013, Curt and Renee have spent their winters in Apache Junction, Arizona, where they both have been actively involved as associate members of Epiphany of Christ Lutheran Church. They both have been involved in activities at Ironwood RV Park and Golden Vista Resort Community, Apache Junction, AZ. They purchased a park model home and lot at Golden Vista.

Early in his young life, Curt became a sports fanatic, first attending local town team baseball games with his dad. All through his life, Curt loved sports; coaching little

league baseball and elementary basketball, was a basketball official, enjoyed watching high school sports, was a diehard fan of the Minnesota Vikings and Minnesota Twins, and attending home NDSU Bison football games with his son, Kris. Curt enjoyed vegetable gardening and became a Master Gardener in Sargent County. He volunteered his gardening knowledge at the Four Seasons Healthcare Center, Forman and with the Forman Community Orchard and Community Garden

projects. He also loved to work on the computer, read mystery novels, work in his woodworking shop and work in his gardens.

Curt and Renee loved to travel and camp in Minnesota State Parks and at KOA parks throughout the country. Their love of camping was passed down to their children and a new experience of spending a week of camping with their children and grandchildren began in 2016. Curt and Renee travelled to Germany and to Norway several times, visiting with cousins and doing genealogical searches.

Survivors include his wife, Renee, married for 52 years; his daughter, Melissa (Dave) Cox, Redmond, WA; and his son, Kris Larson, Fargo, ND; and 6 grandchildren: Elise, Nora, Cayley and Trina Cox; Aidin Faut; and Karina Larson; two sisters, JoAnn (Joie) Heckman, Valley City, ND; Anna Jean Larson (Joe Dinich), Cherry Hill, NJ & Tucson, AZ; brother-in-law, Gerald Sundquist; brother-in-law, Colin (Colleen) Sundquist; sister-in-law, Lynette (Kevin) Anderson; sister-in-law Bev Sundquist; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

Preceding him in death are his parents, brother, Sheldon Larson, numerous uncles, aunts and cousins.
