Myrtis Rae Clark passed away peacefully at Little Hospice in Edina, MN on Thursday, February 13, 2025. She was 88. Myrtis touched many with her warm, beautiful smile and humorous personality. We were all blessed to know someone so selfless, kind and loving. Her everlasting faith in Jesus Christ, her savior, brought her comfort and peace throughout her life.



On March 29, 1936, Melvin and Minnie Larson welcomed Myrtis and her twin brother, Milton into the family on a farm near Warner, SD. Melvin died when Myrtis was 3, leaving oldest brother Udell to keep the spunky girl in line. Myrtis spent her first 12 years on the family farm, attending school in a one room schoolhouse before the family moved to Aberdeen, SD.
