

Museum Minute for June 6, 2025

Yes, we are open for the 2025 summer season. We will again have regular hours of Monday – Friday 10-4. We are also looking at being open at other times. Email or call us and let us know if a certain week night works better for people or would you like open hours on Saturdays.

Email us at sargentcountymuseum@yahoo.com or call us at the museum 701-724-3194. We are trying to get volunteers set up to open on Sundays again this year from 1-4 but at this writing we do not have anyone signed up. We will post on Face Book when we have special openings.

We do have all buildings open. But we do not have the log cabin open due to the decline in it. It has been decided that we will be taking it down this summer or fall. We will try to put as many of the items in the log cabin as we can in the other buildings but if your family has items in that building let us know if you would like them back.

The school house will be closed until we get concrete up to it again so that you can safely get into it. Even then you will not be able to get to it from the other buildings. It will be a walk around the grounds to it to get into it. So, it will not be handicapped accessible when it is done.

We are working hard to get phones back in all the buildings by July 1. We are also working with DRN to get internet into building #3 which is the new building. The new building is climate controlled just like buildings 1 & 2 so it is cooler in the summer and will be warmer in the fall and winter. This makes it nice to visit all the time. Remember once in the front building you can get to buildings 1-4 by hallways. We do have handicapped accessible bathrooms and the lighting in the buildings is just like your home. We are a wonderful place to visit for all ages.

Remember the new building houses the first ever Melroe Keller Bobcat Exhibit which has many examples of the changes in the Bobcat through the years. We also have a STEM play area in the new building and a place to sit down and chat for awhile or to have meetings or get together. We have had car clubs, tractor clubs and more use the space. Make your family visit to your local museum. The Sargent County Museum is located on the north end of Forman just look to the west when entering town. Come check us out!

The funeral service for Joseph “Joe” Kudelka was held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, June 14, 2025 at Trinity Lutheran Church of Forman. Rev. Julie Johnson officiated the service. Interment will be at the Forman Cemetery under the direction of Olson Funeral Chapel.

Joe was born on a small farm near Cogswell, North Dakota on May 17, 1930. The oldest of seven children, he graduated from Forman High School in 1948 and pursued a career in farming. Shortly after, he met Ann Marie Hillestad at a party where she captured his attention by trying to trip him – the trick worked as the two wed in Havana, North Dakota in 1953. The couple had four children and enjoyed life on the farmstead until Ann’s passing in 1983.



Years later, Joe met DiAnna Elizabeth Wilkens Hanson at a singles dance where he poached his friend’s date. He asked DiAnna to join him at The Forman Investors Christmas Party, where a first official date turned into a 12-hour conversation followed by marriage in 1992. Joe often said how lucky he was to have two great loves in his life (closely followed by his forever loyalty to all things Ford and John Deere).

To know Joe, was to know he had the gift of the gab. A “visit” often lasted for hours over a pot (or two) of coffee. He had a genuine interest in how people were doing and could easily strike up a conversation about the land, his beloved Bison football and current events. His impeccable memory – often recalling vivid details from interactions that happened decades ago – stayed sharp into his nineties. He never turned down a strawberry milkshake and his family could always rely on his not-so-secret stash of Salted Nut Rolls and Red Baron frozen pizzas. A man of faith, Joe was committed to serving his community. He volunteered in leadership roles for the Trinity Lutheran Counsel, the Forman Township Board of Supervisors and the Farmers Union Co-op Association (now Full Circle Ag).

Joe’s proudest role was being the patriarch of his large, blended family. He is survived by his wife of nearly 33 years, DiAnna Kudelka, and children David Kudelka, JoAnn (Kent) Jacobson, Paula Berriche, and Julie (Clint) Kudelka; step-children Todd Hanson, Lori Hanson, Randy (Carrie) Hanson and Stacie (Brady) Olson; and his siblings Ruth Ann Kudelka and Thomas (Joann) Kudelka. He left a legacy through his grandchildren Shelley (Justin) Lange, Dana (Nick) Holub, Alexandra Ann Jacobson, Amine Joseph Berriche, Alyssa (Colton) Bonfy, Sam Hanson, Wyatt Hanson, Grace Hanson, Landon (Caylie) Olson, Ian Olson, Brevin Olson and six great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife Ann Kudelka, parents Joseph Kudelka and Genevieve (Wolf) Kudelka, sister Frances Kudelka, and brothers Roger Kudelka, Dennis Kudelka and Eugene Kudelka. Joe passed away Monday, June 9, 2025 at Sanford Medical Center in Fargo at the age of 95.

The Memorial Mass of Christian Burial for Ryan Kersting will be 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 17, 2025 at St. Mary's Catholic Church of Forman. Fr. Tim Schroeder will celebrate the mass and inurnment will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery of Cogswell, ND.

Ryan Kent Kersting was born March 6, 1975 in the Oakes, ND to Doran and Ruby (Cady) Kersting. He grew up on a farm outside of Cogswell, ND and completed high school. He went on to work several different jobs before starting with Hortons in Britton, SD, where he has worked for the past 16 years.



Ryan passed away Monday, June 9, 2025 at Avera McKennan in Sioux Falls, SD at the age of 50. He wasn't a man of many words, but he loved his family, and his family will dearly miss him.

He is survived by his children: Tristin, Liza and Gabriella; his mother, Ruby Kersting; siblings: Arvin (Barb) Kersting, Julie (Marvin) Fliehs, Myron Kersting, Darwin Kersting, Galeyn (Melissa) Kersting, and Kelly (Robin) Kersting; his goddaughter, Lacie; and a number of nieces, nephews and their families.
