

Museum Minute for August 15, 2025

Sargent County Museum here. We have been busy again this summer making this museum a better place for all to visit. We tried being open Wednesday nights in July till 8pm but we did not get a turn out so we will see if we do that again next season or not. We were hoping that would give those of you working during the day a chance to bring the family out on an evening. Our next and last event of the 2025 season will be on Sunday, September 7 from 1-4. It will be a day of Christmas Bingo and making a Christmas ornament. We will have 60 Bingo cards and each person gets one and you need to be at least 6 years old to play. The prizes are wrapped like presents. We will have gift certificates to honey to tee shirts to give away. It will be fun for all ages. This will be in our new building in the open meeting/gathering area on the westside.

We will be open Monday – Friday from 10-4 in August and in September we will see if we are open after the 7th. Depends on the numbers of visitors coming out to see us. The latest we will have open hours will be September 12.

We also have changed our mailing address to Sargent County Museum, PO Box 283, Forman, ND 58032. Mail will be answered by our new treasurer. If mailing big items and items for the museum to have we ask that you hold on to them and send them May-August each year. We also ask that you call (701-724-3194) ask for Pat or email (sargentcountymuseum@yahoo.com) before you send anything. We would like to talk to you about the items before they are sent to make sure we have room for them.

There is still time to set up group tours/visits this summer before we close.

We are also making some repairs around here and would like to talk to any handyman or contractor who is willing to bid out jobs we have to do. We need a hallway enclosed with a ceiling and insulated, we need metal roofing panels replaced on the southside by the parking lot, we need bent roof/snow stops removed on some of the buildings some of this can be done before we close up this year or it can be done next year starting the end of April 2026.

We are also looking for a youth group that is trying to earn money that would work with us to scrap and paint the school next year.

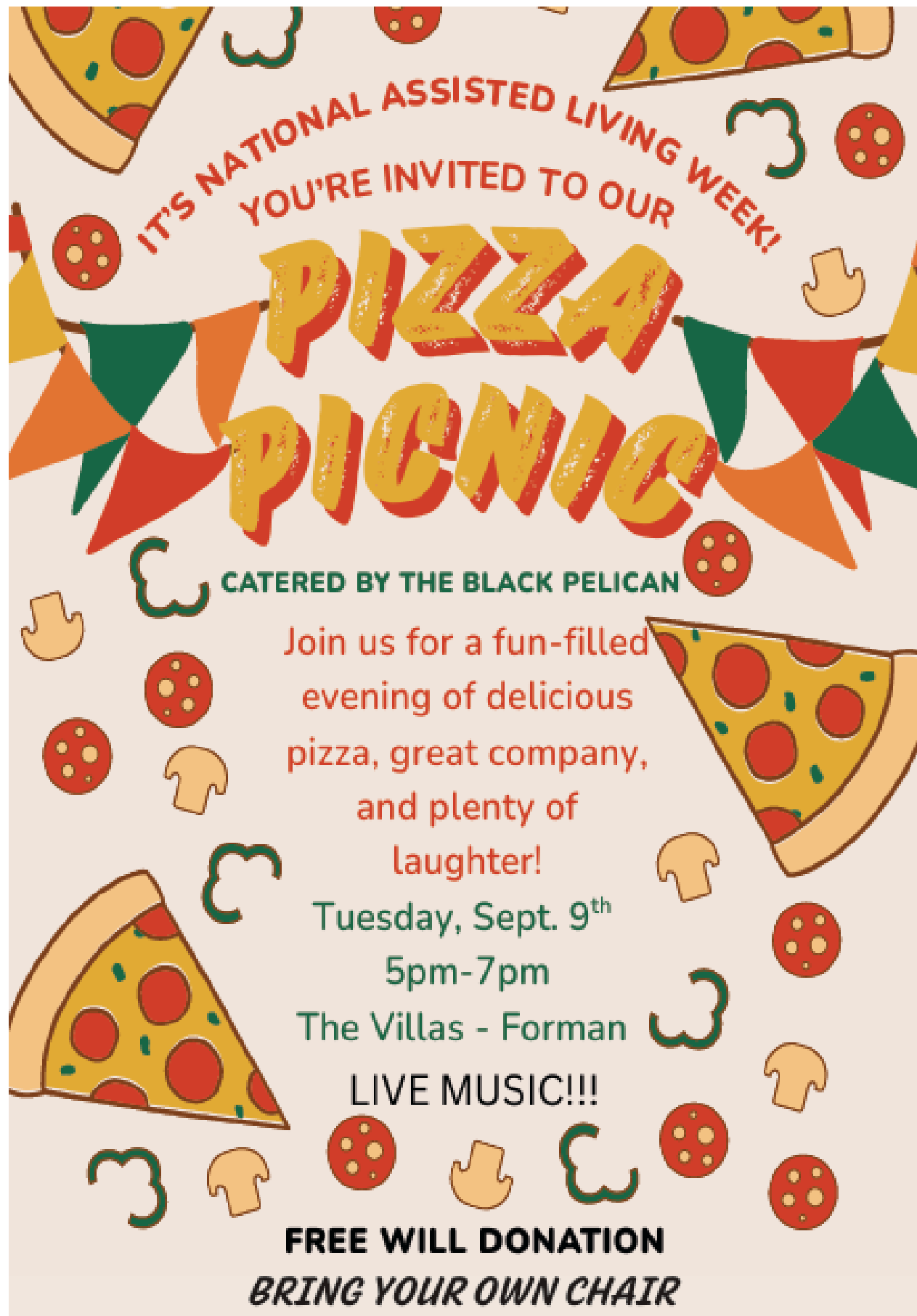

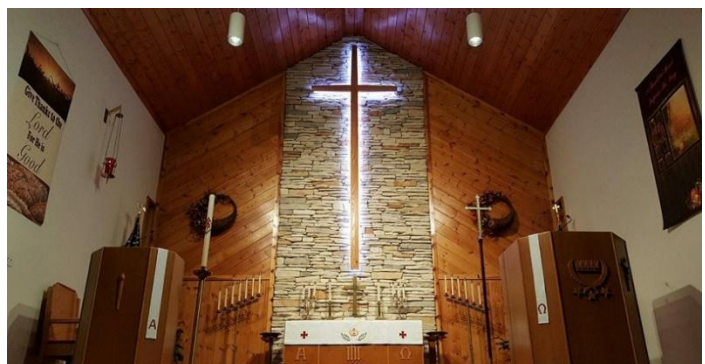
